The Justification of God: Theodicy in Habakkuk

Habakkuk 2:2-20

We live in a world where we experience the effects of wickedness. People die in a building collapse because a construction company decides to cut corners on building materials when constructing an apartment complex. A manager uses his authority to elicit sexual favors from potential employees. A young teenage driver dies because someone decided to get behind the wheel despite having too much to drink that night. When we experience the effects of wicked behavior, how should we respond? What should we do?

1.	The countdown to God's judgment of the wicked has begun (2:2-3)
2.	While the wicked resist God's rule, the righteous submit to God's rule living by faith (2:4-5)
3.	The refusal of the wicked to submit to God's rule causes God's judgmer (2:6-20)

Information about the community

- Lam Binh community in North Vietnam
 - Mountainous, forested area in northern
 Vietnam with tropical weather
 - Agriculture (rice) and forestry; rural and rugged terrain
 - World Vision has been in the community for 3 years, currently in Phase 1: Plan stage

Needs

- Lack of nutrition mostly rice and a few vegetables, lacking in protein
- Limited healthcare and social services
- Poor sanitation and hygiene in homes, lack of clean water
- World Vision program highlights
 - Training farmers in sustainable agriculture practices to secure long-term income
 - Building and fixing public toilets, water sources, and waste facilities (155 from 2020-2021)
 - Training caretakers in positive discipline methods (1,282 adults from 2020-2021)
 - 95 home visits by community and faith leaders to support parents to care and protect children (2021)
