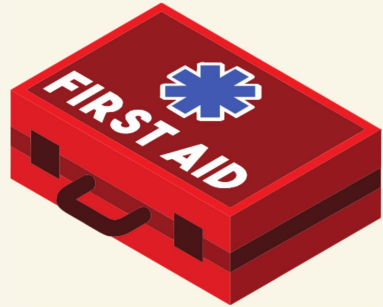

Earthquake Response

On February 6, 2023, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck Turkey and Syria, toppling buildings and killing more than 22,000 people. Thousands more are injured, as the devastating quake hit a wide swath of the region, leaving people homeless during the coldest month of the year.
