NEXT LECTURE: SUNDAY, MARCH 26

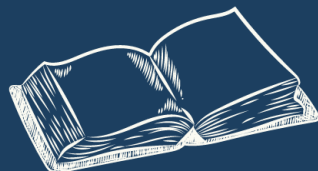
