1 Corinthians: A Letter to a Troubled Church

A Loving Conscience
1 Corinthians 8:1-13

The discord that divides a Christian community can often be traced back to a clash of consciences. In Corinth, that clash concerned the eating of meat offered to idols. Some saw it as a matter of Christian freedom to enjoy; others saw it as a sinful act of idolatry. The preservation of unity – in their day as much as in ours – calls for Christians to tend to their own consciences while being sensitive to other's.

The second lecture in our series on The Works of C.S. Lewis will be presented by Dr. Louis Markos, who also came to speak for our first PTL series ("Christianity and Ethics"). The title of his upcoming lecture on is: "Mere Christianity: From Theism to Christianity." It will be in the sanctuary of Houston Chinese Church at 7:30 pm on April 14th.



Louis Markos, Professor in English and Scholar in Residence at Houston Christian University, holds the Robert H. Ray Chair in Humanities; his 25 books include On the Shoulders of Hobbits: The Road to Virtue with Tolkien and Lewis, and Restoring Beauty: The Good, the True, and the Beautiful in the Writings of CSL. His newest books are C. S. Lewis for Beginners and The Myth Made Fact: Reading Greek and Roman Mythology through Christian Eyes.
