FOSTER CARE & ADOPTION

FOSTER CARE

- TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF A CHILD OUTSIDE OF HIS/HER FAMILY OF ORIGIN WITH THE GOAL OF REUNIFICATION
- INVOLUNTARY (CPS CUSTODY / CONSERVATORSHIP)
- VOLUNTARY (POSSIBLE CPS INVOLVEMENT BUT PARENTS MAINTAIN CUSTODY)
- BIRTH PARENTS HAVE VISITATION WITH THE CHILD TO MAINTAIN A BOND WHILE THE CHILD LIVES OUTSIDE OF THEIR HOME

O ADOPTION

- PERMANENT PLACEMENT OF A CHILD OUTSIDE OF HIS/HER FAMILY OF ORIGIN
- PARENTAL RIGHTS OF BIRTH PARENTS ARE TERMINATED
- ADOPTIVE PARENTS HAVE ALL THE RIGHTS OF A LEGAL PARENT
- OPEN ADOPTION: A BROAD TERM TO DESCRIBE AN ADOPTION IN WHICH THE BIRTH FAMILY HAS SOME DEGREE OF CONTACT WITH THE ADOPTED CHILD OR ADOPTIVE FAMILY AFTER THE ADOPTION IS CONSUMMATED
- CLOSED ADOPTION: BIRTH FAMILY HAS NO CONTACT WITH THE ADOPTED CHILD OR FAMILY

PROVERBS 24:11-12 RESCUE THOSE BEING LED AWAY TO DEATH; HOLD BACK THOSE STAGGERING TOWARD SLAUGHTER. IF YOU SAY, "BUT WE KNEW NOTHING ABOUTTHIS," DOES NOT HE WHO WEIGHS THE HEART PERCEIVE IT? DOES NOT HE WHO GUARDS YOUR LIFE KNOW IT? WILL HE NOT REPAY EVERYONE ACCORDING TO WHAT THEY HAVE DONE? JAMES 1:27 RELIGION THAT GOD OUR FATHER ACCEPTS AS PURE AND FAULTLESS IS THIS: TO LOOK AFTER ORPHANS AND WIDOWS IN THEIR DISTRESS AND TO KEEP ONESELF FROM BEING POLLUTED BY THE WORLD.

HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED? DIRECT CARE OF CHILDREN

- o INTERNATIONAL ADOPTION (permanent)
- o DOMESTIC ADOPTION (permanent)
 - Requires home screening and approval by a child placing agency or court-appointed social worker
 - Finalized by a judge after a minimum of six months supervision
- o FOSTER CARE (temporary)
 - Requires home screening and a license by a child placing agency
- o RESPITE CARE (3-14 days)
 - At minimum, fingerprint background check and TB test (most agencies have more requirements)


