To Live is Christ
Philippians 2:5-11

Jesus sets the supreme example of humility and selfless concern for others. Jesus gave up His divine privileges to become a human being to die on the cross. He rose on our behalf and now empowers us to follow His example. As a result, God elevated Jesus to the place of the highest honor so that every being will bow down to worship Him.

1. The Humiliation of Christ
 - a. The attitude of Christ

 - b. The action of Christ
 - i. Taking the form of a servant

 - ii. Obedient to the point of death

2. The Exaltation of Christ
 - a. God exalted Christ above every name

 - b. Everyone from heaven and earth will confess that Jesus is Lord

MISSIONS SPOTLIGHT: HCC YOUTH

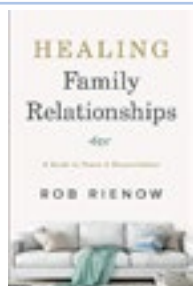

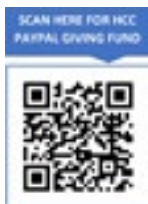
