English Adult Sunday School – Fall 2022 Starting Sept 4th (11:00 am – 12:15 pm)

Systematic Theology Survey (Part 1 of 3)

Led by Jason Tarn, Erik Wiest, Akhil Shenoy, Jackie Yeung, & Chris Chee This survey course will provide you with a strong theological foundation for Christian life and ministry. We will explore key doctrines across the spectrum of systematic theology. In Part One of three consecutive courses, we will cover The Doctrine of Scripture, The Existence and Attributes of God, the Doctrine of Creation, and the Doctrine of Providence.

New Testament Survey (Part 1 of 3)

Led by Jonathan Huang, Melvin Huang, John Hsieh, & Russ Wolters This fall, we will be kicking off the New Testament Survey track, beginning with a big picture look at the books of Hebrews, Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, and Acts. Join us as we explore the biographies of Jesus' life as well as how the gospel initially spread from Jerusalem onward through the Spirit-led missionary activities of God's people. We will learn lessons from these important New Testament books and apply principles found through the example of Christians in the early church.

Old Testament Survey (Part 4 of 6)

Led by Henry Ow, Joseph Goh, & Bill Huang

In the 2-year Old Testament Survey track, we will go through the 39 books of the OT by providing a high level overview of each book and its main ideas/themes. The OT helps us understand God's character and is the foundation for the New Testament. Through the OT, we also learn of God's promises and how they point to Jesus. This 12-week fall quarter, we'll journey through the books of 1-2 Kings and the Pre-exilic Prophets. These books depict the decline of that nation of Israel that results in their

eventual exile into Assyrian and then Babylon. The format of the class will be a blend of lecture, videos, discussion, and sharing. We hope that you can join us!


