- Oversee Youth Ministry while Minister Stan is on Sabbatical (February April)
- Join the Impact/Discovery (Summer Camps) planning team
- Other duties as requested or assigned

- Lead an Oxygen Group (Sunday School Ministry)
- Lead Friday night inSpire (Youth Fellowship)
