Our Father Abraham: A Series in Genesis (Part 2)

The Death of Abraham Gen 25:1-18

Abraham's story concludes with an account of his death – one that is conspicuously bookended by two genealogies listing out his children of the flesh. But the focus is squarely on Abraham's child of promise and his descendants. The juxtaposition of these two lineages challenges the reader to ask, "To which lineage do I belong? With the people of the flesh or the people of the promise?"

While people of the flesh can enjoy God's gifts, people of the promise are

recipients of all his covenant blessings (vv5-6)

2.	While people of the flesh can hope to die after a good long life, people of the promise can hope to live again after death (vv7-8)

3. While people of the flesh can only die in peace if their hopes are met in this earthly life, people of the promise can die in peace knowing their unrealized hopes await a better country (Heb 11:13-16)
