1 Corinthians: A Letter to a Troubled Church

A Set Apart People 1 Cor. 10:1- 11:1

Main Idea: We as God's children should represent God well by being set apart from the world. May we learn from past failures of over-estimating our rights, which led to disunity and even temptation of idolatry. Instead, may we be united in the Lord, who is faithful and has set us free. May we be willing to surrender our rights for the sake of unity in the body.

And he told this parable: "A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. And he said to the vinedresser, 'Look, for three years now I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and I find none. Cut it down. Why should it use up the ground?' (Luke 13:6-7)

In Christ's parable from Luke 13, the barren fig tree is admonished for being useless, taking up space without bearing fruit as designed. It is a warning to repent or perish. A large church building that does not facilitate Gospel ministry is useless in God's kingdom. We must creatively and strategically consider how best to utilize the expanded ministry space we acquire in the adjacent land and building next to the HCC campus.


The new MF building could host some immigrant churches and ministries in our community for Gospel impact. Christian counseling can be conducted in consultation rooms to provide Biblical counseling to HCC members and our community.

We can partner with the Houston Food Bank to provide storage and serve as a distribution station. Dedicated storage space in the building can also help store equipment and stage props for the ACTS performing arts ministry.

A dedicated full-size gym will allow our Sports ministry to organize athletic events on campus and provide open-gym hours to community members.

HCC's Chinese School would have the proper space to offer expanded classes to more community students interested in learning Mandarin.

The only limit to the possibilities for new ministry is our imagination. A renovated Mattress Firm Building affords us the flexibility and adaptability of space to consider many ministries.


