The Promise and the Power

¹³Then Haggai, the messenger of the LORD, spoke to the people with the LORD's message, "I am with you, declares the LORD." ¹⁴And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people. And they came and worked on the house of the LORD of hosts, their God. (Haggai 1:13-14)

In the Haggai's day, the people of God faced challenges to complete a building project. They sought to construct the second temple in Jerusalem, but there was a significant downturn in their economy (1:9-11) and low engagement among their people (1:2-4). Some were saying that it was just not the right time to build. The necessary resources and support were lacking.

But then the LORD intervened. He didn't build the temple for them. He didn't send angels to complete the project. His expectation was for his people to do the job – but not on their own. So we see, in Haggai 1:13-14, the LORD speaking promise and supplying power. Four simple words, "I am with you," were enough to cast off their fear and apathy and to stir up their spirits to faith and action. And Haggai 1 concludes as the construction begins.

Church, let's ponder these things as we face our own challenges to complete our own building project. The LORD has opened a window of opportunity to acquire a substantially larger building and plot of land next door. We might question if this is the right time or doubt if we have the necessary resources or support. But let's not question nor doubt the promise of God's presence and his power to inspire people to great acts of generosity and firm devotion to complete a task.

God is not going to buy the building nor renovate it for us. But he is with us, and he will stir up his people to accomplish his will. So stay prayerful and ask yourself, "In light of this building project, how is the LORD stirring my spirit and what is he calling me to do?" Whatever it is, do it with a grateful and cheerful heart!
