1 Corinthians 11:17-34

Unaddressed division leads to disorder. What contributes to division? Jealousy. Greed. Impatience. Grumbling. The Lord knowing that the church would be susceptible to division gave us a way to remember the unity we have in Christ. A family meal. The Lord's Supper. How does the Lord's supper help us guard against division?

1.	Divisions reveal a misunderstanding of the Lord's supper (11:17-22)
2.	The Lord's supper reminds us of the unity that we have in Christ (11:23-26)
3.	An improper participation in the Lord's supper will result in God's discipline (11:27-32)
4.	Prepare for the Lord's supper by caring for one another (11:33-34)

In the 2-year Old Testament (OT) Survey track, we will go through the 39 books of the OT by providing a high level overview of each book and its main ideas/themes. This 12-week fall quarter, we'll journey through the pentateuch (Gen thru Deuteronomy), which serves as the foundation for God's covenant with Israel. 
