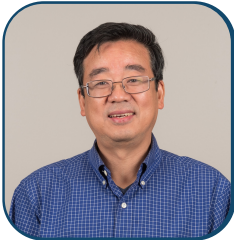
We will introduce the incoming elders and deacons.

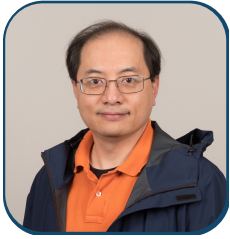
Minxing Chen
