God is... Good

Psalms 145:1-9

We praise people, places, and things we find good. We extol the qualities of our spouses. We comment about the beauty of exotic locales. We express our enjoyment of gourmet meals. But if God is the source of all good people, places, and things, then why do we find ourselves not praising Him more often? This morning, we'll discuss three reasons we should praise God for His goodness.

1. Praise God's goodness because He is the great King (145:1-3)
2. Praise God's goodness because He has done great works (145:4-7)
3. Praise God's goodness because He keeps His covenant promises (145:8-9)

- 7:30 PM – “What Am I?” – Finding our true identity.

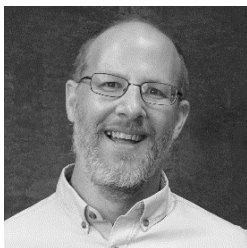
