God is ... Everywhere Psalms 139:7-12

As finite creatures, we can only be in one place at one time. But God is different. He is everywhere all at once. He is omnipresent. Studying God's omnipresence is an experience that can be comforting, chilling, and confounding – all at once.

Defining God's Omnipresence
