# Family Life: A Book Study

# Systematic Theology Survey (Part 1 of 3)

This survey course will provide you with a strong theological foundation for Christian life and ministry. We will explore key doctrines across the spectrum of systematic theology. In Part One of three consecutive courses, we will cover The Doctrine of Scripture, The Existence and Attributes of God, the Doctrine of Creation, and the Doctrine of Providence.

# Old Testament Survey (Part 4 of 6)

Trailer 411

Led by Henry Ow, James Gao, John Hsieh, & Bill Huang

In the 2-year Old Testament Survey track, we will go through the 39 books of the Old Testament by providing a high level overview of each book and its main ideas/themes. The Old Testament helps us understand God's character and is the foundation for the New Testament. Through the Old Testament, we also learn of God's promises and how they point to Jesus. In this quarter, we will journey through the Wisdom literature (the books of Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes and the Song of Songs). The format of the class will be a blend of lectures, discussions, small group exercises and sharing applications for our lives. We hope that you can join us!
