The Coming King: Advent Messages in Matthew's Gospel A Genealogy of Hope Matthew 1:1-17

Every Christian goes through spiritual winters of the soul where we are

	ced to ask ourselves, "Has God stopped working in my life?" Advent is timeless answer to this unsettling question.
1.	Have hope since God never stops working in the lives of his people even though we are flawed (vv2-6a)
2.	Have hope since God never stops working in the lives of his people even when we are under his judgment (vv6b-11)
3.	Have hope since God never stops working in the lives of his people <i>even</i> when he seems absent (vv12-16)

Paul calls us to "press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus" (Phil. 3:14). Billy Graham says, "The greatest legacy one can pass...to children and grandchildren is...a legacy of character and faith." This class reviews what Scripture tells us about how to live in our senior years. It will offer practical advice about leading a life engaged in meaningful Kingdom-minded work, using your unique God given gifts and resources. It will stress the importance of impacting our children's children—intentional Christian grandparenting. There will be applications for those without grandchildren.
