He secured the coveted birthright and blessing, but he now finds himself displaced, sent away from the very land he conspired to inherit. In this chapter, Jacob receives a vision that impresses upon him the accessibility of heaven and all its blessings – not for those who work towards them – but for those who receive them by faith.
