The Dead Shall Rise: A City-Wide Praying & Fasting Initiative (HCPN)

It's Never Too Late John 11:1-44

Our series on spiritual awakenings has centered around passages in Scripture where God raises the dead back to life. Among these, the account of Jesus raising Lazarus stands out as one of the most well-known. This story provides profound insights into how to navigate challenging times when God disappoints us, when we lose loved ones, or when we lose hope amidst suffering.

1. Loving others doesn't mean always shielding them from suffering

2. Believing in the resurrection is not the same as believing Jesus is the resurrection

3. Being upset and grieving the reality of death are right responses

4. Looking forward to the resurrection of the dead is our highest hope
