If God is For Us: The Life and Trials of Joseph

The Big Picture

Genesis 47:1-31

By Genesis 47, the main plot points of the narrative have been resolved. Joseph has ascended to power, the brothers are reconciled, and God's people have been preserved. While the remaining chapters may seem less important, when you read Genesis as the first of the five Books of Moses (Pentateuch), it becomes evident that these final chapters are preparing us for Exodus and the broader biblical story of redemption. When you pull back the lens, each movement in this chapter reveals a larger theological point.

Movement #1: Jacob blesses and Pharaoh prospers

Movement #2: Egypt survives but Israel thrives

Movement #3: God promises and Israel believes

New Testament Survey (Part 2 of 3): Romans to 2 Thessalonians

In the one-year New Testament Survey track, we will provide a high-level overview of the 27 books of the New Testament and study their main ideas and themes. This quarter, we will focus on several of the letters written by Paul, the books of Romans through 2 Thessalonians. In these books, Paul teaches us important truths of Christian theology and key aspects of the Christian life. Through presentations, group discussions, and application of the lessons, we will gain more knowledge of these books and grow in our walk with Jesus.

Christian Ethics (Part 2 of 3): Civic Duty & Civil Disobedience, Just War & Justified Violence, Race & Justice, Marketplace Ethics

Christian ethics studies what is right and wrong from a biblical perspective. Ethical questions and dilemmas are among the thorniest and most complex moral issues that confront us today. Yet, as difficult as it may be, Christians need to address them by answering the questions: "What would Jesus do? What actions and attitudes would receive God's approval? What factors or standards should we consider in making ethical decisions?"

Join us for the second of three quarters that will cover a wide range of ethical topics. For this winter, we will cover the following units:

- **Civic Duty & Civil Disobedience** (e.g., political activism (including Christian Nationalism), legislating morality, civil disobedience, immigration/refugees, etc.)
- **Just War & Justified Violence** (e.g., morality of violence, self-defense (gun rights), just war, etc.)
- **Race & Justice** (e.g., racism, slavery, racial justice/reconciliation, critical race theory, affirmative action etc.)
- **Marketplace Ethics** (e.g., capitalism, socialism, money, workplace ethics, gambling, etc.)

With emphasis on the Bible as our primary source and standard, but also incorporating other relevant materials, sources, and media, we seek to engage and equip attendees with a Christian framework for making ethical decisions with respect to these important subjects. We warmly invite you to join us in this challenging but worthy endeavor.
